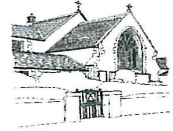

### **St Joseph's Parish Meeting**

Thanks to all those who attended and participated so fully in spite of the very inclement weather.

Lenten tradition puts the Passion of Jesus and his sacrifice at the front of Catholic practice for 40 days. We are asked to go deeper into our souls and come closer to the agony He experienced. Traditionally there are three aspects to our Lenten Observance - Fasting, Prayer and Almsgiving. We agreed a number of activities that relate to each of these aspects.

**Fasting** - Once again all are encouraged to fast on Fridays of Lent, an opportunity to reflect on the sacrifice of our Saviour during his 40 days in the Wilderness. We'd like to encourage you to donate funds saved to SCIAF or Peebles Food Bank.

**Prayer** - Stations of the Cross will take place in St Joseph's on Fridays in Lent at 7pm, each week led by a group. The Rosary will be prayed in St Joseph's Thurs at 6pm.

**Almsgiving** - SCIAF will be running their Wee Box campaign. Details to be given at Mass in St Joseph's Sat 10th Feb. We will also be collecting food and non-food items and donations for Peebles Foodbank. Details will be explained further at Mass in St Joseph's on 3rd Feb. We will distribute a flier 'Lent @ St Joseph's' with more details and how people can support them.
