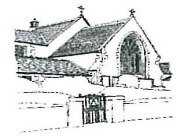

This is an opportunity for us to meet Fr James Mallon and to connect with other parishes through the UK who are at different stages of parish renewal using the process of *Divine Renovation*.

## Divine Renovation Reading Groups

It is really encouraging that around **35-40** people from both communities in our parish are meeting on a weekly basis to read and discuss *Divine Renovation*. Already, parishioners are experiencing the benefits of coming together, discussing live issues in the Church today, and getting to know one another that little bit better. If you haven't come to one of the groups yet, perhaps think about coming this week – a great opportunity to be involved in shaping the parish of the future!

Our reading groups will continue this week on **Monday 4 February from 2pm to 3.30pm**, and **Wednesday 6 February from 7pm to 8.30pm**.

The venue for both groups will be St Joseph's Neighbourhood Centre, Peebles. The topic for this week will be the fourth chapters of the book: ***Clearing out the Junk: What we need to jettison if we are going to rebuild***. In preparation for the group, please read chapter four of the book. However, if you don't have a book, or haven't managed to read the chapter, don't worry.

The session will begin with a summary of chapter three.

The Finance Committee will be working on preparing a budget for the year ahead and building in regular budget reviews to ensure we are able to prioritise monies for essential repairs and renewals in our churches and for the purpose of evangelisation. A more detailed breakdown of Income and Expenditure will be given in a separate statement in the coming weeks.
